# DISTRICT WALKING WEEKEND

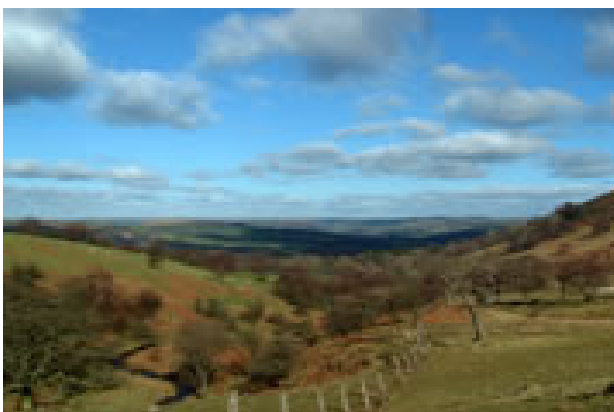
THE PENSTAR BUNKHOUSE, BRECON BEACONS NATIONAL PARK  
FRIDAY 19TH TO SUNDAY 21ST FEBRUARY 2010

The Penstar Bunkhouse was converted from an old barn during the summer of 1996 by the Powell family who have had the farm since 1918. On a working farm the site provides access directly to the Brecon Beacons and to Brecon via the Taff Trail, a recently established long distance walk route. The Bunkhouse is a self-catering facility.

This trip is an excellent opportunity for those who are new to hill walking and those wishing to brush up their walking and navigation skills alike. It's also excellent practice for those going to Kandersteg in the summer!

The accommodation is indoors, in the comfortable surroundings of the bunkhouse. All food will be centrally catered (we'll have a rota so everyone gets a turn to cook! All you need to do is turn up and enjoy the walking!

Places are limited to 16 people and offered on a first come, first served basis, so book your place quickly to avoid disappointment.
